

The vision for 1Mosaic is simple: it's Zero. It's uncomplicated, yet unattainable. It's the number of hurting people we'd like to see in the world: the homeless, abused, poor, divorced, hungry . . . the list goes on and on. When we dive into the data the statistics are staggering! The numbers are mind-numbing! **How can one person make a difference?!?**

Mother Teresa said, "If you can't feed a hundred people, then feed just one." Perhaps that's where we start. **Who is your "one" this year? This week? Today?** Start with just one . . . "I was hungry and you fed me, I was thirsty and you gave me a drink, I was homeless and you gave me a room, I was shivering and you gave me clothes, I was sick and you stopped to visit, I was in prison and you came to me."
(Matthew 25:35-36, The Message)

What is it that God has wired you to do? What is it SPECIFICALLY that God is calling you to do?

"Master, what are you talking about? When did we ever see you hungry and feed you, thirsty and give you a drink? And when did we ever see you sick or in prison and come to you?" Then the King will say, 'I'm telling the solemn truth: Whenever you did one of these things to someone overlooked or ignored, that was me – you did it to me.'" (Matthew 25:37-40, The Message)

Many churches recognized Orphan Sunday this past weekend. It is a day to bring attention to the needs of orphaned children around the world. The Biblical meaning of the word "orphan" in James 1:27 is "fatherless, abandoned, deprived, destitute, and defenseless." **But did you realize that we are all spiritual orphans until we recognize our need of a Heavenly Father?** And we can only be redeemed through Jesus, by accepting Him as our Savior. Because of this great love, we must in turn bless others. After accepting this great gift, **how could we respond any other way?**

Mother Teresa said, "I never look at the masses as my responsibility; I look at the individual. I can only love one person at a time - just one, one, one. So you begin. I began - I picked up one person. Maybe if I didn't pick up that one person, I wouldn't have picked up forty-two thousand....The same thing goes for you, the same thing in your family, the same thing in your church, your community. Just begin - one, one, one." A vision of zero? This goal will not be reached until Christ comes again, but I can bless one person today ("it made a difference to that one"...*The Starfish*), and that's one more than yesterday.
