# Walking Dusty...

In the midst of the parable teaching from Mark 12, Dan said “*How we live matters.*” Since Sunday, I’ve thought about this phrase a lot. Quite often I live for me, and I don’t think about how my choices will affect other people.

**HOW** *we live matters*: How are we living? How do we spend our time? How do others see our priorities? How do we care for others? Are we producing fruit?

How **WE** *live matters*: As Christ-followers, we should look different than the world. Do we? What do others see? What makes us different? Is Jesus who others see in us?

How we **LIVE** *matters*: Has Jesus’ love transformed how we live? Are we living responsibly? Is Christ at the center of how we live? Does our relationship with Christ affect how we treat others?

How we live **MATTERS**: To whom does it matter? Are we spending our time and money wastefully? Is it spent on helping the poor, the disadvantaged, or those without an advocate?

## Questions to Consider:

The Greatest Commandment is “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. And love your neighbor as yourself.” (Matthew 22:37, 39) How we live matters to God and our neighbor. How should we then live?
